

5 Facts about the Temporary Assistance For Needy Families

Program

TANF is cash assistance for poor families with children

TANF provides monthly cash benefits to families with children and with very low incomes. Parents must meet work and other requirements to qualify for the program.

TANF is funded by a \$330 million federal block grant and \$173 million of state Maintenance of Effort (MOE)

The max Monthly benefit for a family of 3: **\$280**

TANF benefits in Georgia have lost 45% of their purchasing power since 1996.*

Most children live with relatives

4,303 of the total 4,521 TANF cases are children who live with relatives. In these cases, the TANF benefit only covers the child/children, not other family members.** Many of these families help keep children out of foster care but receive little financial support.

Single mothers and adults caring for a relative's children often need cash assistance to keep their families stable. However, TANF needs to be updated. Georgia legislators should support HB 565 which would make significant improvements to the TANF program.
